## Entry into the course

- Students must have an Australian Higher School Certificate or equivalent
- Student must pass Working with Children Check in the state or territory you are planning to work in , prior to work placement.
- Student must have a vaccinations against infectious disease prior to work placement.
- Student must hold a CHC30121 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care or CHC30113 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care
