Career Start/Boost –Traineeship

The non-concessional fees for traineeships are at a regulated \$1.60 per nominal hour in each unit of competency, while the concessional fees are \$0.64 per nominal hour in each unit of competency.

There are no fees to any individual who is eligible for a Government subsidy under the Free Apprenticeships for Under 25s initiative. The Department will cover the Co-contribution fee.

There is no Co-contribution fee where a student falls into one of the following categories:

- Skilling Queenslanders for Work or SQW participants – this training is provided fee-free to Students with any additional costs met through SQW funding.
- Specific fee-free training programs as announced by the Queensland Government.
- Foundation skills – this training is fee-free.
- Lower-level vocational Qualifications for concessional Students – this training can be provided fee-free to Students, as determined by the SAS.
